Remember: Tipping is extra money and should be based on quality of service, you do not NEED to give anyone a tip.

On your wedding day the planning team will hand out the tips for you. Please have them in a sealed envelope clearly indicating who the envelope is for. A thank you card is always a nice touch!

If our team is also handling a final payment that should also be in a sealed envelope SEPARATE from the tip envelope.

OFFICIANT

\$50



IF YOUR OFFICIANT IS PART OF THE CLERGY, MAKE A DONATION IN THE SAME AMOUNT TO THE CHURCH.

STANDARD

PHOTOGRAPHER

\$100-\$250



IF THE PHOTOGRAPHER HAS BROUGHT AN ASSISTANT FOR THE DAY, TIP THEM \$50 ON TOP OF THE PHOTOGRAPHERS TIP.

OPTIONAL

*this also applies to videographers

HAIR & MAKE UP

20%



LIKE AT THE SALON, TIP 20 PERCENT OF THE SERVICE. YOU MAY PROVIDE THIS TIP YOURSELF IF YOU'RE PAYING FOR ALL OF YOUR BRIDESMAID'S SERVICES, OR INCLUDE A TIP IN THE TOTAL

STANDARD

MUSICIANS

\$50 each



IF GRATUITY IS NOT INCLUDED IN YOUR CONTRACT WITH THE MUSICIANS, TIP BETWEEN \$25 AND \$50 PER PERSON.

OPTIONAL

FLORIST

\$100



THE AMOUNT YOU TIP IS CONTINGENT ON THE LEVEL OF INSTALLATION YOUR FLORIST IS PERFORMING.

OPTIONAL

\$200-\$1000



THE AMOUNT TIPPED IS CONTINGENT ON THE LEVEL OF SERVICE YOU HAVE BOOKED.

TYPICALLY BASED ON 10% OF THE TOTAL INVOICE
STANDARD

NOTE: VENUS, CATERERS, BARTENDERS & DRIVERS OFTEN INCLUDE A GRATUITY ON THEIR BILL. IF IT IS NOT COVERED BY YOUR CONTRACT, 15-20 PERCENT OF THE PRE-TAX BILL IS A GOOD RANGE TO AIM FOR.
